

MEETING REPORT

Meeting Type: Digital and Connectivity Subgroup

Date: 22/6/2020

Present: Neil Davis, Ian McChesney, Jill Block, Lucy Davis

Summary of Conversation:

1. Econometrics person from Cornwall Council will help with providing data on the evidence of need in various areas.
2. We need data on the various needs in order to decide where best to put resources on implementing digital capability. Jill has some of this data.
3. Transport and energy subgroup are proposing a transport hub which will require software to run the business which includes a “bay to bay” cycle network.
4. Sports and wellbeing Centre will need digital systems to operate reception desk, event publicity, court and event booking etc.
5. It is important to understand what is meant by growth – increased footfall or greater spend in town, more revenue retained in the town etc. Question to be included in questions to BID.
6. ODI Leeds could do a feasibility study on data mapping. They will look at our mission statement and advise what they could do.
7. All new buildings should be wired for cable and mobile communications.

- **Jill** to send to subgroup data that she has collected on needs in St Ives
